## LARCENY FROM THE PERSON



On Thursday, June 30, 2011, at approximately 4:20 PM, a female was the victim of a Larceny on board a northbound Route #1 bus on Mass Ave. between Boston Medical Center and MBTA Mass Ave Station. The female was on the bus, when she made contact with a male and female (pictured above). Upon exiting the bus, the female realized her wallet was missing.

Further investigation revealed at approximately 4:27 PM, at MBTA Symphony Station the depicted male and female used the victim's credit card to purchase \$177.00 in Charlie Cards.

**The two suspects are described as:**

1. A black male in his, early 50's, short, with a thin moustache.
2. A white female in her mid 40's, with blonde hair and missing teeth.
