ARMED ROBBERY (KNIFE)



On Sunday, November 27, 2011, at approximately 7:22 PM, a 53-year-old male was the victim of an Armed Robbery at Mattapan MBTA Station.

The victim was on the platform waiting for an MBTA Route #33 bus, when he was approached by an unknown male who brandished a large knife. The suspect pointed the knife at the victim and demanded then took the victim's wallet and money. The suspect then fled on Blue Hill Avenue toward Cummings Highway.

The suspect (pictured above) is described as:

A black Hispanic male, 30-40 years of age, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, green sweatpants, and a white baseball cap
