UNARMED ROBBERY



On Friday, November 11, 2011, at approximately 11:40 PM, a 34 year old male was the victim of an Unarmed Robbery at Ruggles MBTA Station. The victim was on the Orange Line platform when he was approached by Suspect #1, who robbed him of his iPhone. The second and third males numbered above were observed interacting with Suspect #1 prior to the robbery.

The suspects are described as:

1. A dark-skinned black male, 17-22 years old, medium build, wearing a grey hooded sweatshirt
2. A Hispanic male in his early 30's, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, and a black baseball cap with a white "sox" emblem on the front
3. A light-skinned Hispanic male, 17-25 years old, wearing a black jacket, blue jeans, and white sneakers with black laces

The MBTA Transit Police Department is requesting assistance from the public in identifying these three individuals.
