UNARMED ROBBERY



On Friday, December 2, 2011, at approximately 11:15 AM, a female passenger was the victim of an Unarmed Robbery at MBTA Hynes Station.

The victim was waiting for a Green Line trolley, when she was approached by the male (pictured above), who grabbed her iPhone and fled toward Massachusetts Avenue.

The suspect is described as:

A light-skinned Hispanic male, 15-20 years of age, approximately 5'10" in height, approximately 160 lbs., wearing a black jacket with a white logo on the front, blue jeans, and brown shoes.
