LARCENY UNDER \$250



On Sunday, 10/30/2011, at approximately 12:30 PM, a female was the victim of a Larceny while on board an MBTA Route #1 bus.

The female boarded the bus at Harvard Square Station and traveled to Hynes Station, later realizing her wallet was missing. She then discovered her credit card was fraudulently used at Symphony Station to purchase Charlie Cards. A review of surveillance footage shows a male (pictured above) fraudulently using the victim's credit card.

The suspect is described as:

A black male, 5'6"-5'08" in height, approximately 50 years of age and wearing a black leather jacket, and black sunglasses.
