On Tuesday, December 6, 2011, at approximately 10:30 AM, a Larceny occurred at The T Stop convenience store, located at MBTA Park Street Station.

CCTV footage shows an unknown male (pictured above) taking an employee "Tip" jar from the counter, placing the jar into a bag, and fleeing the area. The owner of the store believes the jar contained approximately \$300.00.

The suspect is described as:

A white male, 170-180 lbs., 5'07"-5'09", with short hair, wearing a blue coat with a white stripe across the chest, dark jeans, and carrying a blue bag with a strap.'
