UNARMED ROBBERY



On Sunday, January 29, 2012, at approximately 1:00 PM, a 23-year-old female was the victim of an Unarmed Robbery while on board an inbound Red Line train.

As the train approached MBTA JFK/UMass Station, the victim was approached by the two males depicted above, who grabbed her iPhone from her hands and fled the station along with two other males (not pictured).

The suspects are described as follows:

1. White or Hispanic male, 18-20 years of age, 5'11", slender build, wearing a red hooded sweatshirt, jeans, work boots, and a red, white and black baseball hat.
2. Black male, 18 years of age, 5'5", wearing a grey hooded sweatshirt with a white logo, khaki pants, white sneakers, and a black knit hat.
