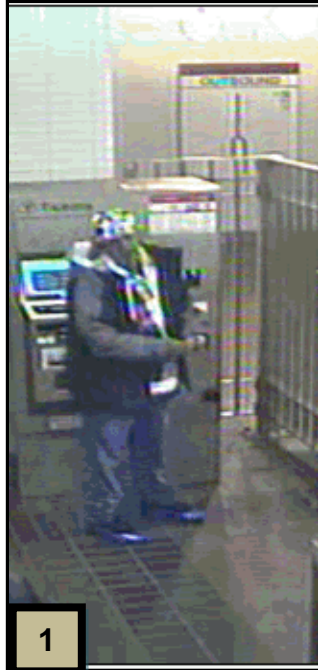
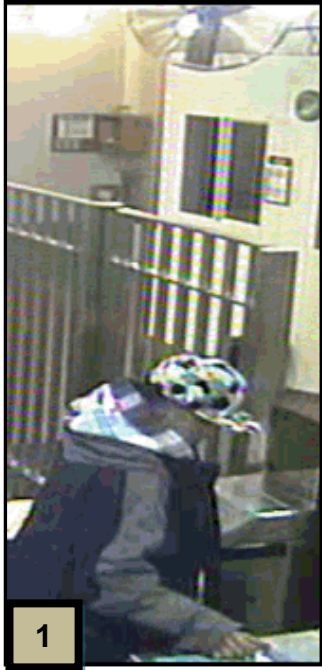

Identification In

ARMED ROBBERY (FIREARM)



On Friday, December 23, 2011, at approximately 10:15 PM, a 24-year-old male was the victim of an Armed Robbery while on board a Red Line train.

The train was stopped at Fields Corner Station, when the victim was approached by two unknown males (pictured above). One of the males pointed a black handgun at the victim, while the other male went through his pockets, taking his iPhone and \$120.00 in US currency. Both males then fled the train.

The suspects is described as:

1. A Hispanic male, 18-19 years of age, 5'08"-5'10", with long black hair, wearing a black North Face jacket and black pants
2. A Hispanic male, 18-19 years of age, 5'04"-5'06", wearing a black do-rag, short black jacket, and black sweatpants
