The MBTA will host an additional public meeting to highlight plans for major renovations at Wollaston Station. During construction, in consideration of rider safety and a shorter overall project timeline, the project will require the station to be shut down for a period of 20 months. MBTA representatives will discuss specifics of the closure, project timeline, engineering plans, parking mitigation, bus shuttle service as well as other project related topics.
